The ideal candidate will hold a good degree in an environmental or science discipline, with additional relevant work experience. They will be physically fit, able and willing to carry equipment. Good written and oral skills are essential. Experience of working with volunteers would be an advantage. A full UK or European Driving Licence is essential.

These posts will be temporary contracts and whilst working hours cannot be guaranteed, the successful candidates should expect to work 37.5 hours per week between July and October weather permitting.
